Truth for Today:

Today I choose to believe that Jesus' love and grace can be reflected in how I parent my children. Remember that God loves you and your children. He is more than capable of transforming your parenting style, no matter how you've acted in the past. If you love your children, pray for your children and share His truths with them, He'll do the rest.

Activity Options:

Option #1: Find a scripture that reflects what you want for your home or your kids. For example, you could search for Bible verses about peace if you'd like to focus on that. Then invite your kids to pray that verse with you often. Aim for consistency rather than frequency.

Option #2: Write down what you see happening in your life as you get to know Jesus and/or a few reasons why you love Him. Then actively look for an opportunity to share one of those happenings or reasons with your kids. (If you have younger kids, like my youngest, who is 6, sharing simple words during storytime or playtime could work! For example, recently, during a tough day, I put on worship music and invited my youngest to sing with me. I told her I feel better when I refocus and think about Jesus.)
