Week 5

- God sent His Son, Jesus, into the world through a virgin named Mary. Jesus, fully human and fully divine, took on flesh and lived a perfect life.
- John the Baptist ushered in Jesus' ministry by baptizing Him. Present in that moment to validate Jesus' ministry was God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.
- After Jesus' baptism, the Holy Spirit led Jesus into the wilderness where Satan tempted Him, appealing to the lust of His flesh, His eyes and His pride. Jesus did not succumb to temptation, but fought back with the Word of God.
- Jesus called His twelve disciples. Jesus gave His famous message, the Sermon on the Mount, setting forth the "Beatitudes," the attitudes in which we should "be."
- Jesus brought James, Peter and John to the top of a mountain, called the Mount of Transfiguration. Moses and Elijah joined them atop the mountain to hear God confirm that Jesus is His Son. This is the second time God called Jesus by this name.
